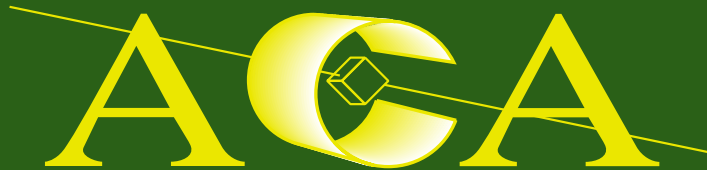

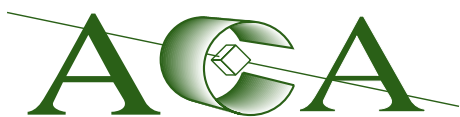

General Information

The **Annual Meeting of the American Crystallographic Association** will be held **July 22-27, 2000**, in **St. Paul, Minnesota**. The meeting will begin on Saturday, July 22, with three workshops, followed by lectures and poster sessions from Sunday, July 23 through Thursday, July 27. An exhibit show is planned for Sunday through Wednesday. All technical sessions, poster presentations and the exhibit show will be held in the **RiverCentre**, 175 West Kellogg Blvd., St. Paul, Minnesota. (www.rivercentre.org). Dr. Purnell W. Choppin, President, Howard Hughes Medical Institute, will be presented with the ACA Public Service Award for 2000. A special session recognizing the activities of the HHMI in biomedical research and crystallography and dedicated to Paul Sigler, is planned for Wednesday, July 26.

The **Exhibition Show** is being managed by the Advertising and Exhibits Division of the American Institute of Physics; Bob Finnegan, Advertising and Exhibits, AIP, 2 Huntington Quadrangle, Suite 1N01, Melville, NY 11747-4502, Phone (516) 576-2433, Fax (516) 576-2481, rgf@aip.org.

An exhibition of the latest instruments and techniques for sample isolation, purifications and preparation; crystal growth and data collection, of computer software for data storage, retrieval analysis, of graphics systems and databases; and book, journal, and other materials essential to the conduct of modern crystallographers is scheduled to begin on the afternoon of Sunday, July 23 and run through Wednesday, July 26. The show will be held in Exhibit Hall A of the RiverCentre.

Two blocks of sleeping rooms have been reserved at the **Radisson Hotel St. Paul**, 11 East Kellogg Blvd., and the **Radisson Inn St. Paul**, 411 Minnesota St. Both hotels are within easy walking distance of the RiverCentre. Rates are \$98/single or double; triple \$108; quad \$118, plus taxes, at either hotel. The deadline for reserving a hotel room is June 20, 2000. Exhibit Hall Floor Plan

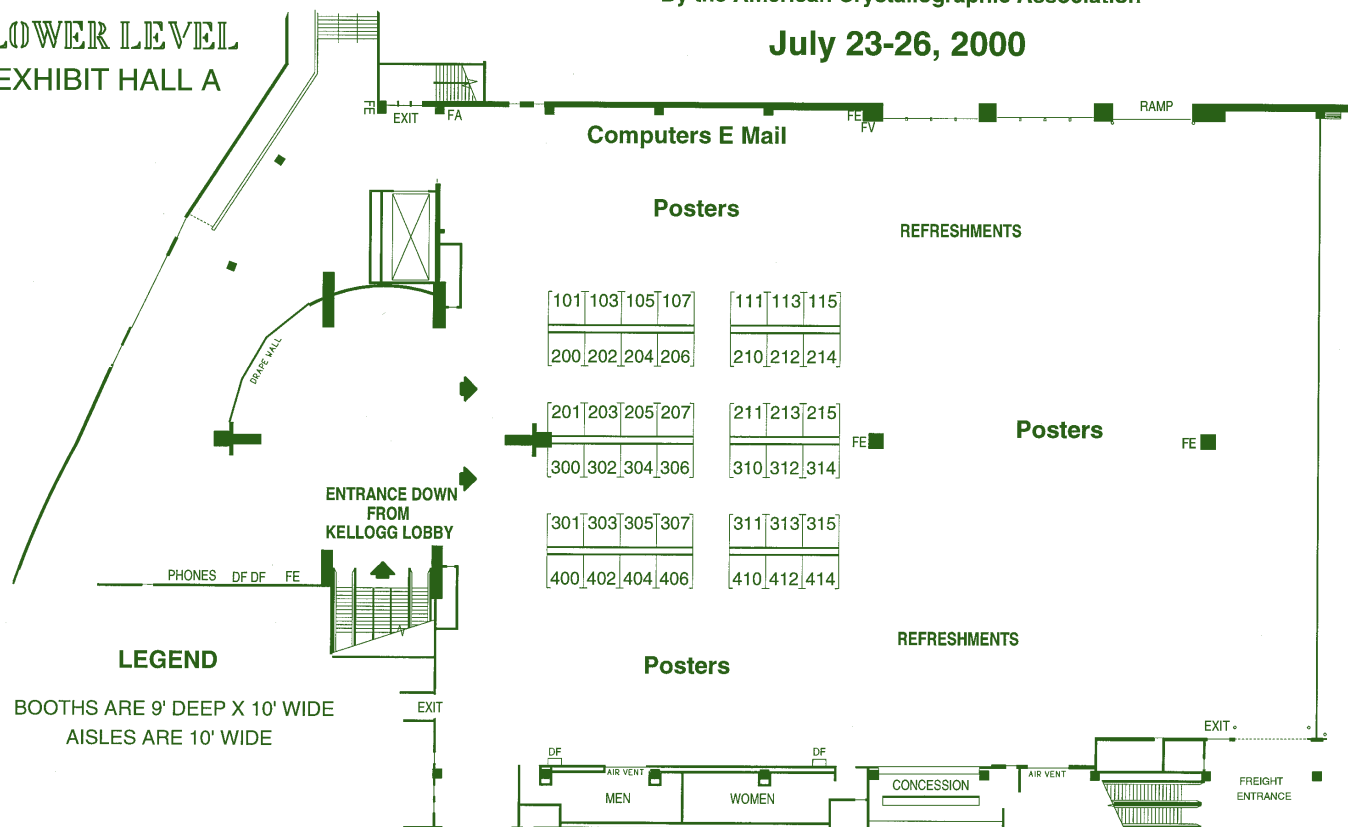
